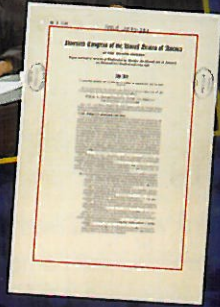
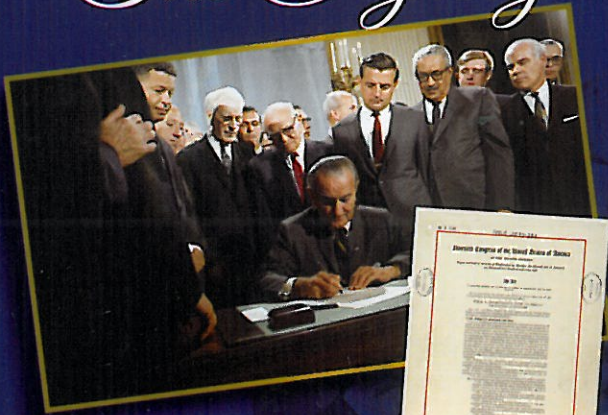

In May 1990, NAREB's board of directors approved the signing of a Voluntary Marketing Agreement between the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) and NAREB. The document served as a mandate to the assurance of free fair housing choice for all Americans as written in Title VIII of the Civil Rights Act of 1968, known as the Fair Housing Act. This Agreement was executed on November 14, 1990 in Washington, DC by Jack Kemp, HUD Secretary and Evelyn A. Reeves, NAREB President.
